Larry V. Shumway is a professor of humanities and musicology at BYU with degrees in music education (BA) from BYU, Asian studies (MA) from Seton Hall University, and ethnomusicology (PhD) from the University of Washington. When he joined the BYU faculty in 1975, his contract was to teach both humanities and music, and he has continued in this joint appointment throughout his career.
